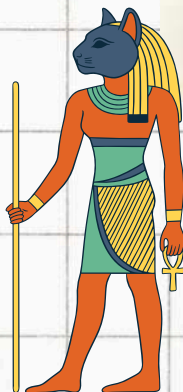
This term, our core text is Ma'at's Feather by Juliet Desailly. We began our learning by making predictions based on the front cover. In English, we have been writing newspaper reports about the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb, and we have also started to plan and write a diary entry from the perspective of an Egyptian farmer.
