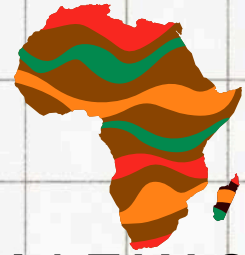

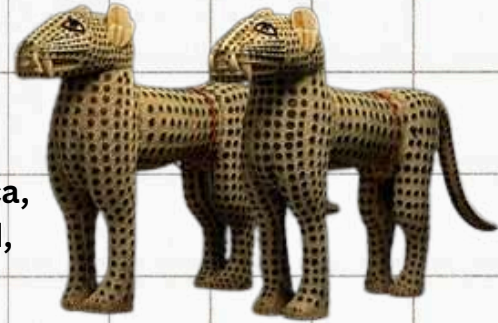

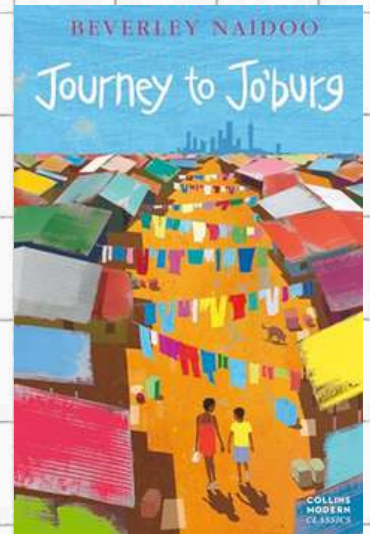
## OUR TOPIC THIS TERM IS AMAZING AFRICA

In the week commencing 17th November, we'll send out a form so you can choose your refreshments in advance. Extra treats and drinks will also be available to buy on the day.

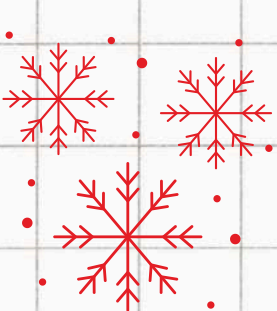
### Attendance Details
